In this section, the qualitative research design process will be discussed within the framework of various qualitative approaches/patterns. Then, the preparation and reporting of interview and focus group interview forms used in the qualitative data collection process will be included. Finally, approaches in mixed method research will be discussed. In this section, quantitative and qualitative data collection process and quantitative and qualitative data integration and analysis will be analyzed through practical examples.
